



1. Take out the light fixture and accessory pack from the packaging.



2. To take out the lens: Hold the raised middle part of the lens and apply a downward and inward force. One end of the lens will detach from the metal clip, allowing you to remove the other end as well. Tilt the lens inside the light fixture to remove one end first, then take out the entire lens. How to install the lens: Hold the raised middle part of the lens, tilt one end of the lens and insert it into the fixture first then insert the other end. Clip one end into the metal clip first. then pull the other end into the clip. Adjust the position of the lens as needed.




3. Remove the lens from the fixture, peel off the protective film on the lens, and take out the internal packing material. After removing the packing material, place the lens back into the fixture.






4. Pry open the illustrated mounting hook by hand.



5. Place the light fixture into the mounting bracket.



6.Unscrew the cover plate of the driver box, pry open the reserved hole, connect the black and white power wires, and connect the purple and pink dimming wires as needed. After completing the operation, close the cover plate of the driver box.



7. Slide the switch to select the appropriate color temperature and power.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Clean with a mild, non-abrasive glass cleaner and soft cloth. Do NOT use solvents or cleaners containing abrasive agents. When cleaning the fixture, make sure the power is turned off, and any liquid spray should be applied to the cleaning cloth and not sprayed directly onto the fixture itself.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution	Corrective Action
Fixture does not light.	Power is off. Incorrect wire connection. Defective wall switch.	 Check circuit breaker or wall switch. Check wire splices. Replace switch.
Circuit breaker trips when light is turned on.	Crossed wires or power wire is grounded out.	Verify wires are correctly connected.
